Colline Chillen City



1. For this rig you need Incognix rig material, a Long Shank or Gripper hook, rig rings, and shrink tube.



2. Strip a piece of coating of the Incognix and tie a little hair loop on the end of the braid



Put the hook bait of your choice on the hair, so that we can determine the perfect distance between the hook and the bait.



4. Slide a little rig ring on the hair



5. Now tie the ring to the braid using a simple knot. Make sure that you tie it at the right distance from the hook bait.



6. Put the coated side of the rig through the eye of the hook



7. Fix the hook on the rig by using a knotless knot. Try to position the rig ring approximately opposite from the hook point



8. Now slide a piece of shrink tube over the eye of the hook



9. Shrink it with steam in a nice bent shape and you will see the turning effect this shrink tube has



10. Now tie a standard swivel on the end of the coated part to finish the rig



11. Here you see how the hook will follow the bait when it is ejected by the carp. It is completely free to hook while flying out the carp's mouth
